## Promoting Independence: Teaching Daily Living Skills

Linda will be discussing such things as goal-setting, barriers to learning, activity analysis, learning styles, behavioral principles, behavioral procedures/ techniques (e.g. grading an activity, chaining, errorless learning), and adaptive/compensatory strategies. *The topics are quite general and can apply across ages and diagnoses.*

If you want to share some of the difficulties you are experiencing with teaching daily living skills, we can problem-solve as a group. If there is extra time, Linda will also go through some case studies.
